The 2017 USASA National Championships will host dual sanctioned events for all Open Class Snowboard and Open Class, Junior & Youth Freeskier competitors.

- \*FIS Membership Required
- Open Class Skiercross

Up to \$10,000 of prize money is available to be awarded for all 2017 USASA National Championships Open Class events. Prize purse is based, by gender and the number of Open Class competitors in the field of the discipline.

### **Open Class PGS, PSL, SBX Event Requirements**

#### **Athlete Requirements**

- **Entry Fee**
  - \$325
    - \$30 each additional event
  - Includes credential which allows up to 7 days riding between April 1<sup>st</sup> thru April 13<sup>th</sup> 2017
  - Includes training day ticket for March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 SBX official training day
- **Foreign & domestic competitors must hold a current USASA membership**
  - USASA Domestic - \$100
  - USASA Foreign - \$35 (\* does not score USASA National Points)
- **All domestic competitors must hold a current USSA National Competitor membership and a current FIS license**
  - USSA - \$150.00 (\* Foreign competitors do not require a USSA license)
  - FIS - \$85 (\*required by all Open Class competitors)
